I. Rationale

Rollins recognizes the value of engaged scholars who bring their expertise to the classroom and the college community.

II. Definitions

Full-time, renewable non-tenure-track faculty in the College College of Liberal Arts (CLA) are defined as those persons holding the ranks of artist-in-residence, executive- or entrepreneur-in-residence, instructor, or lecturer.¹

III. Principle

Full-time, renewable, non-tenure-track faculty appointments in CLA ideally constitute no more than 15% of the full-time faculty of the College of Liberal Arts.
