## I. Purpose/Introduction/Rationale

Rollins recognizes the value of engaged scholars who bring their expertise to the classroom and the college community.

## II. Definitions

Full-time, renewable, non-tenure-track faculty in the College College of Liberal Arts (CLA) are defined as those persons holding the ranks of artist-in-residence or senior artist-in-residence; clinical assistant, associate, or full professor; executive- or entrepreneur-in-residence; instructor; lecturer or senior lecturer; scholar-in-residence; teaching fellow; or visiting post-doctoral fellow.<sup>1</sup> Full-time, renewable, non-tenure-track visiting assistant, associate, or full professors may also be appointed to replace faculty on sabbatical or other authorized leaves of absence.

## III. Procedure or Application

Full-time, renewable, non-tenure-track faculty appointments in CLA ideally constitute no more than 15% of the full-time faculty.
