Course Description: An exploration of the cultural differences between the United States and Vietnam in the context of the Vietnam War. The cultural differences between the United States and Vietnam led Americans to misunderstand Vietnamese culture and the nature of the Vietnamese resistance to French colonialism and the American intervention. This class will focus on the cultural basis for going to war in the context of the differences in what Vietnamese and Americans were fighting for and why.

GRADING: There will be two written assignments and two in-class tests. The writing assignments will incorporate class lectures, class discussions and the reading. The assignments are designed to elicit from the student an understanding of the material and the ability to apply that understanding to the assignment. The tests will cover the material presented in class and the reading. Each assignment and test will be worth 100 points for a possible maximum total of 400 points. The exact requirements for the written assignments will be presented in a separate handout.
